### Precision Rifle

Mark your calendars for the Precision Rifle Division's annual Varmint shoot on October 20, 2018! The Precision Rifle Division will be hosting one of its most popular long-range shooting matches where shooters will be given a scorecard and will have 21 different steel varmint targets to engage, at ranges from 300 – 615 yards. Exact distances to the targets will be provided.

The targets consist of prairie dogs, feral pigs, and coyotes.

Shooters must work in tandem with a spotter to confirm their "hits." So, this is a good match to shoot with a buddy. If you have a spotting scope, binoculars, or high-magnification rifle scope, please bring this equipment so you can spot "hits" for your partner. The person to hit all their targets in the lowest amount of rounds wins the match! Shooters are limited to 80 rounds for this match, so take your time and make your hits count. Any caliber between .223 cal and 300 Win Mag are acceptable (i.e., no 338 lapua magnum or 50 cal BMG). In addition, no steel core projectiles or rounds with a velocity over 3,100fps are permitted.

Cost for this match is \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members, and match fees will be collected during registration (please have exact change). Registration will start at 9:00 a.m., meet in the Clubhouse parking lot. A safety brief will start at 9:30 a.m., all shooters must be in attendance in order to participate. The match will begin immediately after the safety brief and should wrap up around noon. If you have additional questions, please contact the Precision Rifle Division match director.
